

## Healing Scripture

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and **heal** their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14 NKJV)

O LORD my God, I cried out to You, And You **healed** me. (Psalms 30:2 NKJV)

Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am weak; O LORD, **heal** me, for my bones are troubled. (Psalms 6:2 NKJV)

Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who **heals** all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies, (Psalms 103:1-4 NKJV)

He sent His word and **healed** them, And delivered them from their destructions. (Psalms 107:20 NKJV)

He **heals** the brokenhearted, And binds up their wounds. (Psalms 147:3 NKJV)

Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. It will be **health** to your flesh, And strength to your bones. (Proverbs 3:7-8 NKJV)

My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, And **health** to all their flesh. (Proverbs 4:20-22 NKJV)

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are **healed**. (Isaiah 53:5 NKJV)

Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your **healing** shall spring forth speedily, And your righteousness shall go before you; The glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. (Isaiah 58:8 NKJV)

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to **heal** the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; (Isaiah 61:1 NKJV)

Return, you backsliding children, And I will **heal** your backslidings. Indeed we do come to You, For You are the LORD our God. (Jeremiah 3:22 NKJV)

**Heal** me, O LORD, and I shall be **healed**; Save me, and I shall be saved, For You are my praise. (Jeremiah 17:14 NKJV)

For I will restore **health** to you, And **heal** you of your wounds, says the LORD, Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Zion; No one seeks her." (Jeremiah 30:17 NKJV)

Behold, I will bring it **health** and **healing**; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth. (Jeremiah 33:6 NKJV)

Come, and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will **heal** us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. (Hosea 6:1 NKJV)

I will **heal** their backsliding; I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him. (Hosea 14:4 NKJV)

But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With **healing** in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves. (Malachi 4:2 NKJV)

And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. (Matthew 4:23 NKJV)

Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was **healed** that same hour." (Matthew 8:13 NKJV)

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed** all who were sick, (Matthew 8:16 NKJV)

"Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** every sickness and every disease among the people. (Matthew 9:35 NKJV)

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to **heal** all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease." (Matthew 10:1 NKJV)

**Heal** the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give. (Matthew 10:8 NKJV)

Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He **healed** him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw. (Matthew 12:22 NKJV)

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and **healed** their sick. (Matthew 14:14 NKJV)

And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and **healed** them all. (Luke 6:19 NKJV)

So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and **healing** everywhere. (The twelve are sent out) (Luke 9:6 NKJV)

Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. And **heal** the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' (The seventy are sent out) (Luke 10:8-9 NKJV)

And one of them, when he saw that he was **healed**, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, (The story of the ten lepers) (Luke 17:15 NKJV)

So when Peter saw it, he responded to the people: "Men of Israel, why do you marvel at this? Or why look so intently at us, as though by our own power or godliness we had **made this man walk?**" (Acts 3:12 NKJV)

Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to **heal**, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. (Acts 4:29-31 NKJV)

"....to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of **healings** by the same Spirit," (1 Corinthians 12:9 NKJV)

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be **healed**. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. (James 5:14-16 NKJV)

In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the **healing** of the nations. (Revelation 22:2 NKJV)

Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and how she was **healed** immediately. (Luke 8:47 NKJV)

And He said to her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has **made you well**. Go in peace." (Luke 8:48 NKJV)

Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to **heal** them. (Luke 5:17 NKJV)
